Culture Corner: Power

The three biggest companies in Sweden are Volvo (as we all know and love, cars), Ericsson (multi-national networking and telecommunications company), and Vattenfall. Vattenfall is a multi-national power company owned by the Swedish State. Beyond Sweden, the company generates power in Denmark, Finland, Germany, the Netherlands, and the United Kingdom.

The company's name is Swedish for "waterfall", and is an abbreviation of its original name, Royal Waterfall Board (Kungliga Vattenfallstyrelsen).

With climate change as one of the greatest challenges of our time – our world urgently needs to change and find alternative ways of generating electricity and heat.

To contribute to the solution and become fossil free within one generation, Vattenfall has pledged to reduce its CO2 emissions and thereby reduce its carbon emissions throughout the entire value chain. The goal is net zero by 2040 for their operations, suppliers and customers. To make it happen, they are working together with customers, partners, authorities, and cities. They call it their CO2 roadmap. Meeting this goal means greenhouse gas emissions need to be roughly halved by 2030 and to achieve net zero by the second half of the century.
